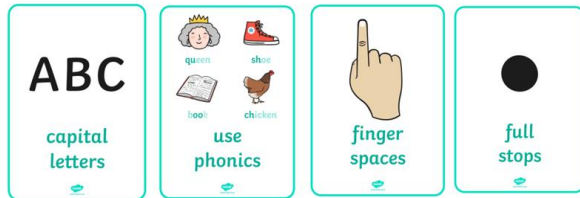


Personal, Social and Emotional Development

In PSHE lessons the children will learn the skills of perseverance and resilience by taking on some new challenges such as building towers, den building, team races and circus skills.

Literacy

This term we will be continuing with our daily phonics and handwriting sessions and introducing the children to the 4 key things needed to make a super sentence:



We will also be providing the children with lots of opportunities to explore their writing in a variety of different contexts throughout their COOL time.

Expressive Arts and Design

Term Three- Around the World!



Understanding the World

During this term we will be thinking about the season of Winter and looking at the changes we can see in the world around us. We will be looking at different places that are special to us and our community.

We will learn about contrasting landscapes and the different animals that live there. We will also be thinking about the different jobs our parents have and learning about some of the roles different people play in our local community.

Physical Development

The children are continuing their weekly PE sessions with Mr Churchward - **please remember to send them into school wearing their PE kits every Thursday.**

The children will be experimenting with moving and travelling in a range of ways and learning how we need to hold our muscles tight when we perform balances. We will be learning how to jump and land safely from a height.

We will continue to develop our fine motor skills in a variety of activities and in handwriting we will continue to focus on correct pencil grip and letter formation.

Mrs Finch will also be continuing with wood work sessions.

Mathematics

We will continue to work from the White Rose Maths Scheme. We will be looking at the numbers 0 to 8, looking carefully at how we can make these numbers in a variety of ways. We will be introducing the children to the concepts of addition and doubling and how we can write number sentences. We will be investigating the language associated with mass and capacity.

SMSC

We will continue to develop the children's social skills through regular class discussions and high expectations of behaviour. We will help the children to learn the skills needed to share and take turns. There will also be an appreciation of other cultures when learning about Chinese New Year as well as during our new Nationalities week.
