

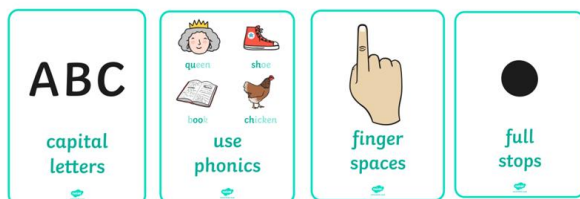
Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Literacy

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will making special cards to take home this half term for Mother's Day and Easter. We are going to be using many different materials to complete art activities with the children linked to our weekly books.

Physical Development This term Reception will continue with their weekly PE session with Mr Churchward. We will be completing a series of dance lessons where we will be learning to move with control and co-ordination and express our ideas through movement to music.

Mathematics Over the next term we will introduce children to measuring length, height and time. We will be learning more about how we can compose numbers to 10, including learning our number bonds to 10. Towards the end of the term we will be learning about 3D shapes.

Understanding the World

In History we will be looking at photographs of us as babies and thinking about how we have changed since we were born. We will also be learning about the importance of recycling for our planet and the things we can do to help.

In science we will be looking at the changes we can see in the world around us as we enter the season of Spring.

In our RE sessions we will be learning about the Christian Festival of Easter and how it is celebrated around the world.
