## Expressive Arts and Design

The children will be using many different materials to complete art activities linked to our weekly books.

Physical Development This term the children will continue with their Thursday PE session with Mr Churchward. The children will be developing their ball skills by developing accuracy when throwing at a target as well as developing their dribbling and kicking kills.

Mathematics Over the next term the children will focus on numbers beyond 10 and explore the pattern that numbers follow as we count. We will then learn about division in the form of sharing. We will also be exploring 2-D shapes this half term.
