# Personal, Social and Emotional Development

At the beginning of this term we will discuss why we celebrate Bonfire Night and how to keep ourselves safe around fireworks. In our Jigsaw sessions this term we will be talking about similarities and differences between ourselves and our friends.



## Literacy

Now that the children have been taught the single letter sounds we will be encouraging them to blend these sounds in order to read short words. We will be teaching the children how to hear, read and write sounds in CVC words. When writing children are encouraged to stretch the words to enable them to hear all of the sounds that they contain in order to write them. The children will be bringing books or sound sheets for you to read with them at home. Please read 5 times a week with your child and record it in their reading comments book.



Expressive Arts and Design Bonfire night, Diwali and Christmas gives us the opportunity to get creative with lots of art and craft activities throughout the term and we can guarantee some very glittery children coming home!

## Communication and Language

We will be encouraging the children to develop their vocabulary as we talk about festivals based on their own experiences of Bonfire night and Christmas.
