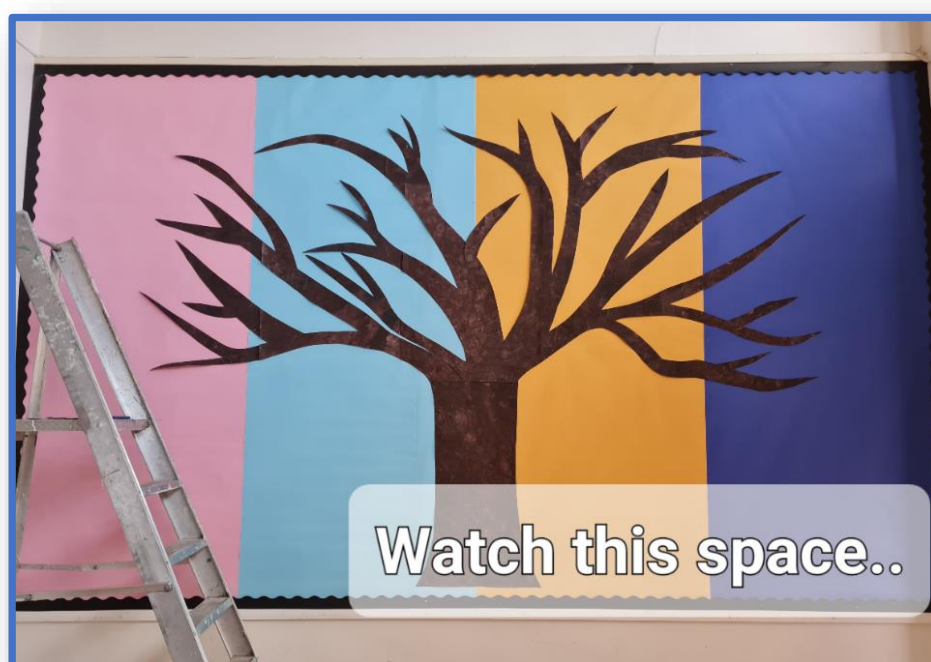


Dear Parents/Carers
