Reception PE Tuesdays

When we come back to school after Easter Reception will be doing PE on a Tuesday morning. They will be getting changed into their PE kits so can you please send in their kits in their PE bags. Over the holidays the reception team would be very grateful if your child can practise getting changed into their kits then back into their school uniform. As you can imagine for some children this is a huge challenge so lots of practise will help. Thank you.

Fresh Start

Please make sure that you have ordered your child's meals for when we come back through meal manager. The deadline to order for the first week back is Thursday 8th April at 12 noon. The deli option is only the one that is listed each day the children **DO NOT** have the option of different fillings so please make sure that your child likes the filling that is on the menu. The jacket potato option is the same children can no longer choose a filling, again it is what is listed on the menu.

Pupil Progress Meetings

The first week back after Easter a letter will be sent out with dates and time slots for the pupil progress meetings. You will then be able to email your class teacher with your required date and time slot. Teachers will then set these up through Microsoft teams so the date and time will be added to your calendar.

The children will restart their lessons from Tuesday 13th April with Mrs Jenny Hubble who taught them before she went on maternity leave. Please make sure that your child has their instrument in school.

Reading Eggs

Many of you have really enjoyed using Reading Eggs and there are many different activities that your child can access. Every child in school has a log in which is in the back of their reading comment book, so if anyone has not yet used reading eggs try it over the holiday it's great for keeping the phonics and reading going.

Dodgeball and Football

These will continue after the Easter break with the same children. The new football children will start on Tuesday 20th April and parents will have had a letter already if your child has a place.

Track and Trace

As was the case at Christmas, there is an expectation that school leaders will support with Track and Trace during the first 6 days of the Easter holiday. Here is the information that you need to know: -

Positive COVID cases

If your child's symptoms first appeared after 28th March, you DO NOT need to contact the school in the holidays. You should use the national test and trace system.

You should email office@waynfleteinfants.co.uk if:

- your child develops **symptoms** on any day up to the end of **Sunday 28th March** **AND** goes on to have a **POSITIVE** COVID test on or before the 1st April

You need to give your child's name, the date when the symptoms first appeared, the date of the test and the date when the result was received.

You DO NOT need to let the school know if:

- symptoms first appeared AFTER 28th March
- your child has a test and the test result is NEGATIVE
- you have a test after the 1st April

What will the school do if a positive case is notified?

The school will identify which pupils were in contact with the infected pupil during the infectious time (up to two days before the symptoms appeared).

Parents of these pupils will receive a school comms telling them the dates when their child should isolate. If you need advice about this during the holidays you should refer to the [NHS website](#).

Please remember that you are required to keep your child at home if anyone in the household has symptoms until the person with symptoms has a test which proves to be negative, or for 10 days, whichever comes first.
