

English

Kinetic Letters- We have learned all of the letter families now so will recap each family and capital letters too.

Spelling - The children will bring home spellings which they need to be able to read and write.

SPaG- We will look at spelling words ending in y or ve

Phonics - New sounds are taught each week, blending plus a weekly 'hold a sentence' session.

We will design our own pirate maps and use these to write a pirate story.

We will also write a factual report about the Titanic in the format of a newspaper report.

Maths

We will continue to form our numbers correctly and count in ones, twos, fives and tens.

We will be learning multiplication and division.

We will look at fractions by finding halves and quarters of shapes and amounts before ending the term with positional and directional language.

We are using the White Rose scheme to deliver our Maths lessons and further challenge will be provided where needed by using Maths Mastery problem solving challenges.

Art and Design Technology

We will have time to practise the skill of colour mixing before our main art activity this half term. We will paint and collage a sunset picture using blue and green painted paper to represent the sea and orange and yellow painted paper to represent the sand.

PE

We will develop our sending and receiving skills each week.

In dance, we will learn a pirate dance, practise some country dancing, Morris dancing and Maypole dancing.

History/Geography

In History we will hear the story of Grace Darling. We will also learn all about the Titanic - who built the ship, what it was like on board and how it sank.

In Geography we will use Google Earth to look at each of the countries in the United Kingdom including some famous landmarks. We will find out more about the culture of each of the 4 countries as well as their capital city and the seas that surround them.

ICT

We will use programmable toys to input instructions and debug when things don't go to plan!

Science

Following on from grouping animals into herbivores, omnivores and carnivores, in science this term we will classify animals into amphibians, reptiles, fish, mammals and birds and we will look at the characteristics of each group of animals.

Our investigation linked to the topic of animals (including humans) is to answer the question: Do people with the biggest feet need the biggest gloves?!

Music

We will also learn about rhythm and begin to use symbols to represent rhythm in music.

RE
